

We Mow, but YOU are still responsible

The NHA wants you to have a sense of pride in your community and in your home.

Things to remember about your yard.

1: If your flower beds are not maintained and weeds removed, we will remove the flower bed and mow that area. You will be asked not to replace the flower bed.

2: Flower beds must have an approved outdoor landscaping material border or edging around them so the Contractor mowers will be able to identify that it is a maintained flower bed.



3: If you plant flowers and put yard ornaments out that prevents mowers to mow under normal conditions, then you will be responsible for maintaining your yard and/or will be charged for mowing your yard. Excessive conditions would be weed eating your whole front yard. Riding mowers will need to be able to have access to mow your front yards.

4: Make sure your yard is picked up from trash, toys, dog leashes, and other items that would prevent mowers from mowing your yard by stopping and moving the items to mow. If yards are not accessible, you will be charged \$30 to mow your yard. **THIS INCLUDES DOG feces and CAT litter.**

Remember, the NHA mowing your yard is not a requirement, it's a privilege.
