Eliminating Mold in Your Bathtub

YOU MUST REMOVE ANY EXCESS MOISTURE

First: Use Ventilation by turning on your bathroom exhaust fan for at least 30 minutes before and after showering or bathing. You can run the fan and/or open the window to remove any excess moisture.

Second: Dry Surfaces by using a squeegee or a towel, but the water must be removed from the bathtub walls, edges and especially under and behind items such as shampoo bottles and soap left in the tub or shower.

Third: Clean Frequently, the bathtub areas must be cleaned with a spray or cleaner to remove soap scum, dirt, and any mold that may start from excess moisture.



Mold is due to moisture and cool/hot air. The bathtubs must be dried of all moisture including shower curtains, towels or wash clothes that are left laying in the bathtub. Air circulating and keeping your bathtub dry is important to not having mold. If we remove your mold, you will be charged.
